ENSURE YOUR AIRCRAFT WILL STAY WITHIN WEIGHT AND BALANCE LIMITS Flight crews are constantly challenged to adapt to changes, but aircraft limits aren't flexible. The responsibility to assure aircraft stability and performance ranks above convenience. Have a process that avoids any guesswork when evaluating late changes and empowers crews to make and implement safe decisions.

- ▶ Resist underestimating when factoring weight of people, baggage, cargo, and fuel.
- ▶ Load in a way that keeps the aircraft's center of gravity in safe range and prevents cargo from shifting.

- Scrutinize changes; confirm it's safe to take extra passengers or heavier-than-planned cargo.
